What is the Mead?

- Nestled in the valley of the Little Eau Pleine River, the George W. Mead Wildlife Area encompasses over 33,000 acres of open marshes, hardwood and aspen forests, and grasslands.
- Third largest wildlife area in Wisconsin.
- Mead's diverse habitats harbor an abundance of wildlife species such as deer, turkey, bear, otter, herons, prairie chickens, foxes, frogs and turtles.
- An important resting, feeding, and nesting site for migrating waterfowl, shorebirds, and songbirds.

What is McMillan?

- Near the headwaters of the Little Eau Pleine River, McMillan Marsh Wildlife Area is a diverse landscape of wetlands, woodlands, and grasslands.
- The area is approximately 6,500 acres in size and is located in the southwest corner of Marathon County, just one mile north of the city limits of Marshfield.

The Department of Natural Resources manages the Mead and McMillan Wildlife Areas to maintain and enhance habitats that support wildlife.
